Dear Mt. Carmel Family and Friends,

At once the Spirit forced Jesus out into the wilderness. He was in the wilderness for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among the wild animals, and the angels took care of him. (Mark 1.12-13)

The 40-day season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, February 14. We will gather that night at 7:00pm at New Market UMC for a service of prayer, meditation, and ashes. I will be assisting Pastor Scott with the service and expect that many of you will come and join us. Lent comes from an old English word for lengthen as in this time of the year the days are getting longer – have you noticed?! Lent is the time we remember Jesus fasting in the wilderness. Some people fast or give up things for Lent. This year, I would ask you to reflect on any bad habits that you have and pray to God for strength to give it up for Lent. But then after Easter, do not think you will return to the way it was, but realize that if you can give it up for 40 days, you can give it up for life.

It also might be that you want to take up something for Lent. Take up a practice of daily devotions, form a small group, come to a Sunday school class, Bible study, or some other intentional spiritual discipline this Lent. To help us on this spiritual Lenten journey this year a daily devotional from the Society of St. Andrew, similar to the one we had during Advent, will be available for all individuals and families of the church. You will be invited to pick one up the Sunday before Lent begins and then read and meditate each day through this season as we prepare for the Easter resurrection.

Human Reltions Day


